RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING MAY 3, 2016 AS THE “LOCAL DAY OF GIVING” IN SOLANO COUNTY

WHEREAS, Solano County is a great place to live, learn, work and play; and

WHEREAS, meeting the needs of all Solano County residents is a high priority of the Solano County Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, local government and the nonprofit sector work collectively to deliver the critical services Solano County residents rely upon, provided by the nonprofits that call Solano home; and

WHEREAS, the Solano County nonprofit sector is still challenged with securing outside funding, receiving only \$3 per capita in foundation gifts to support operations compared to our neighboring Bay Area Counties such as Contra Costa who receives \$27 per capita, Napa who receives \$22 per capita, and Sonoma who receives \$55 per capita; and

WHEREAS, the Solano Community Foundation recognized the need for an increased local philanthropy presence and led the local Solano effort to join the national Give Local America campaign; and

WHEREAS, non-profit participants play a key role in outreach to utilize a collective fundraising approach to market the campaign, using outreach strategies such as: social media, meetings, presentations, print media, and radio; and

WHEREAS, “Give Local Solano” will leverage the national presence of Give Local America to unite and inspire residents, businesses, friends, and families in making a local difference by supporting causes that mean the most to them; and

WHEREAS, “Give Local Solano” will raise awareness of current needs and charitable opportunities in our community and increase the capacity of local nonprofits to serve; and

WHEREAS, twenty-nine participating nonprofits will be the recipients of funds raised on May 3, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims May 3, 2016 as the “Local Day of Giving” in Solano County, encouraging all residents to invest locally, increase philanthropy, and support stronger communities for Solano residents.
