REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS

26-0553 Consider/Discuss/Act on Funding Recommendations for the FY 2026-2027 Transit Homelessness Response Grant

Community Services Administrator Shirletta Best gave a presentation on the overview of the deliberation and funding recommendation process. The Commissioners discussed and provided comments regarding Transit Homeless Response Grant applications from two nonprofit agencies: The Samaritan Inn and Hope Restored Missions. Commissioners recommended that \$20,000 be allocated to The Samaritan Inn. The recommendation will move to City Council for approval in October. Commissioners unanimously approved the motion by Commission Andrea Harvey-Rodgers, seconded by Commissioner Eniola Campbell.

26-0554 Consider/Discuss/Act on FY 2026-2027 Funding Recommendations,
Consolidated Grants Program

Shirletta Best provided an explanation of the Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan process, priorities, federal and city administered budget for funding allocations. Commissioners were instructed to provide minimum of \$3,000 funding recommendations under the Community Support Grant, to include Homeless Response Warming Stations, Non-Profit Capacity, and minimum of \$5,000 under the Community Development Block Grant as applicable. Staff provided explanations of funding recommendations for each agency as a guide. Two discussions were completed at the end: Prior to discussing Community Food Pantry recommendations, Vice Chair Andrea Harvey-Rodgers recused herself and returned after discussion was concluded. Prior to discussing Volunteer McKinney, Chair Tammy Chewe recused herself and returned after discussion was concluded. The Commissioners provide recommendations primarily under public services programming.

After discussion and consideration, Commissioners unanimously approved the motion by Commission Tammy Chewe, seconded by Commissioner Silvia Escamilla, to Approve 26-0554 Consider/Discuss/Act on FY 2026-2027 Funding Recommendations, Consolidated Grants Program to City Council as follows:
